If our trust is root fully in God however giving becomes a celebration of that freedom that God gives over the things of this world. Being called not to worry is one of the hardest calls that God places on us but once we can achieve it it is also one of the greatest gifts He gives. Let this week be one of prayerful consideration but this Sunday let us celebrate together the freedom and joy that God gives.
