Last week in worship, we met two cousins, Elizabeth and Mary.

Elizabeth had lived much of her life fighting doubts about her worth, shaped by a false narrative that tied a woman's value to her ability to bear children. Something she had been unable to do. And then she conceived, beyond the age of what was reasonable or possible. She carried a child whose purpose was to *prepare the way for the Lord*.

Her much younger, unwed cousin Mary fled her home, escaping whispers, stares, gossip, and harsh judgment. She lived under the very real danger of being condemned for adultery. And yet, she too carried a child—the child through whom the world would be saved.

In their stories, witness, and call, we saw that God brings **unexpected joy** to those the world never expected to belong in God's kingdom.

As followers of Jesus, we too are called to share joy in unexpected ways.

There is joy for the brokenhearted, those who are hungry, those who mourn, and joy for those who may not yet know God's love—but experience it through the hospitality, grace, and love we offer.

This week we will talk about Merciful Love. Give Psalm 89:1–4, 19–26 & Luke 1:57–80 a read and let the Holy Spirit start to stir in your heart and prepare you for what God has to say to us on Sunday.
